These interviews extend to the bleeding edge of contemporary *Star Trek*, from *Discovery* to *Picard* to *Lower Decks*, and even the upcoming highly anticipated 2022 series, *Strange New Worlds*. For fans who know every detail of each *Enterprise* bridge, to a reader who has never seen a single minute of any *Star Trek*, this book aims to entertain, inform, and energise.
