The book also reproduces three short stories and a text about the poet John Keats written by the director, along with actress Holly Hunter's 'Scattered Memories' of their collaboration on *The Piano* and *Top of the Lake*. A detailed bibliography and filmography of the filmmaker complete this volume, which contains more than 300 colour and black-and-white illustrations.
